The City of Akron's Fire Department is facing tough economic challenges, and has been forced to lay off 38 firefighters in an attempt to offset a projected budget deficit of \$8 million by the end of the year. The City of Akron Fire Department's proposal seeks to preserve current staffing levels and rehire the 38 displaced workers.

These staffing levels are crucial for the Department to continue to protect the more than 200,000 residents of the City of Akron, the 5th largest city in the State of Ohio and the 97th largest city in the United States.
