I write today to support the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency in its efforts to secure an official recognition from the U.S. EPA of improved air quality in Southern Ohio. It is my understanding that a public hearing was held in Portsmouth, Ohio on April 21, 2011.

The Ohio EPA has stated that the Huntington-Ashland area meets the 1997 federal fine particulate standard and that current air pollution controls will enable the area to maintain the necessary levels of air quality.
